Marriages were Created to Reveal God

5 Foundational Principles of Marriage

I. Two Genders Equally & Fully Image God (Gen 1:26-27)

A **DISTINCT** plurality vs **DUPLICATE** plurality

- 2. Marriage = Two Distinct Genders Covenanted to Each Other for Life (Gen 2:18, 24)
- 3. Role Distinctions in Marriage Reveal God (Gen 2:7, 21-22)

I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet. <u>For</u> Adam was formed first, then Eve. **ITim. 2:12-13**

4. Marriage Involves a New Alligience & a Lifetime Commitment (Gen 2:24 a&b)

"...to have and to hold, in sickness and in health, for richer or for poorer, to love, honor, cherish and forsaking all others til death do us part" **Book of Common Prayer Marriage Vows**

5. Sex is a Sublime Gift Reserved for Marriage Alone (Gen 2:24 c)

"Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. Eph. 5:31-32

When Paul wanted to tell the Ephesians about marriage, he did not just hunt around for a helpful analogy and suddenly think that "Christ and the church" might be a good teaching illustration. No, it was much more fundamental than that: Paul saw that when God designed the original marriage He already had Christ and the church in mind.
